Per NASSCO Bylaws, Directors shall:

- Be elected for a term of two years
- Be at least eighteen (18) years old and represent or work for a voting Member entity in good standing (provided not more than one (1) representative of a voting Member entity shall be eligible for election as a Director)
- Be part of the Contractor, Supplier or Consulting Engineer NASSCO membership category
- Preferably have shown commitment to NASSCO through active Committee participation
- Attend at least two Board meetings each year
- Be prepared to cover expenses to attend Board meetings, when required

In addition to the leadership of a Board that represents all segments of our industry, NASSCO wishes to include representation of the Public Agency sector (municipal agencies, system owners, industrial or government agencies responsible for underground sewer, water, stormwater or process systems). To further this goal, the NASSCO Bylaws adopted last year provide that the Public Agency membership segment shall appoint a Public Agency Advisor to serve as an advisor to the Board of Directors in a non-voting capacity. We are seeking nominations for this position as well.
