



# -ATTENTION- IMPORTANT PACP POLICY

PACP Certification shall be valid for a period of 3 years from the date of issuance. PACP Users who are not recertified within this 3-year period shall be afforded a 1-year grace period during which they are eligible to attend a recertification class. If certification lapses beyond the 1-year grace period, those individuals may only become certified by successfully passing the initial PACP Certification Class.

## Note:

1. Individuals who are within the 1-year grace period are NOT considered certified.
2. Individuals who were certified in MACP and LACP will be required to recertify their MACP and/or LACP certification in addition to PACP by their PACP Expiration date beginning January 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2018.
3. MACP and LACP Recertification may be obtained either by taking the class online or by attending the One Day MACP/LACP class.
