IMPORTANT RECERTIFICATION POLICY

- Certification is valid for 3 years from the date of issuance
- Certification can be verified on nassco.org
- Notifications are sent via email 6-months prior to expiration
- Recertification
 - Must be completed **prior to** expiration to remain certified
 - May be completed online or in a classroom **prior to** expiration (includes MACP and LACP)
- If certification lapses, individuals **must attend the initial training class** to become certified again (this also applies to MACP and LACP)
- NASSCO Members get at \$50 discount on PACP Recertification

Note:

1. Effective May 1, 2021 NASSCO will no longer offer a one-year grace period for certified individuals who allow their PACP certification to lapse
2. As of January 2, 2018, individuals who are certified in MACP and LACP are required to recertify their MACP and/or LACP certification in addition to PACP by their PACP Expiration date
